Just tap any credit or debit card to ride.



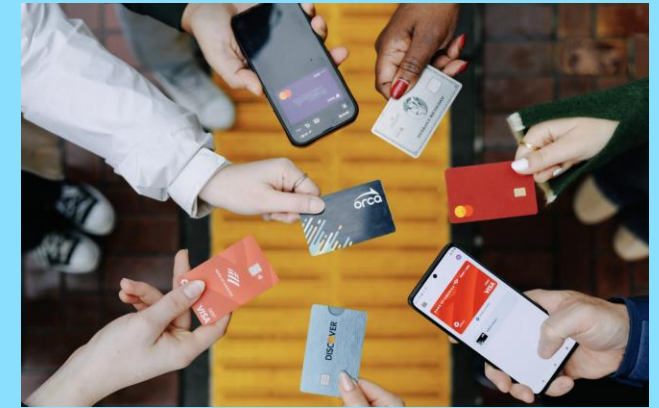
Key Benefits



Reduce wait times to buy fare and board for large events and peak travel times.



Allow infrequent riders to travel more easily.



Streamlines fare collection operations by reducing non-ORCA payment methods like cash, paper tickets and transfers, and flash passes.

Adult Fares

Tap to Pay customers are charged an Adult fare. ORCA cards will continue to be the best choice for customers who are eligible for reduced fare.

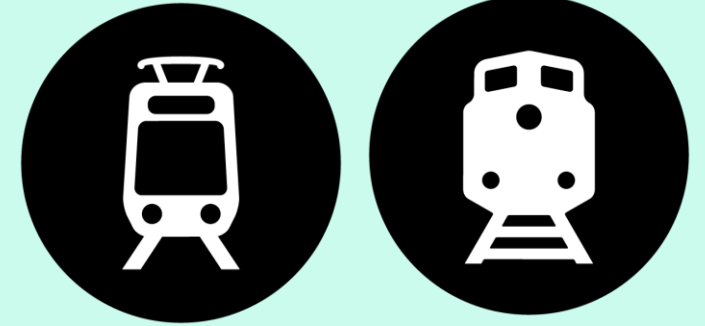

*Tap to Pay is not accepted on Washington State Ferries, Seattle Monorail, Paratransit, Vanpool, and rideshare services. *Kitsap Foot/Fast Ferries and King County Water Taxi will not be live at this initial launch but will accept contactless payments on those ferry services soon.*

What to Know



- **One Rider Per Card**
 - Riders will still need their own card for each trip and cannot pay for multiple riders using one card
- **2hr Transfer Benefit**
 - Riders receive the same two-hour ORCA transfer window benefit on most services
- **Take Card Out Of Wallet**
 - Riders will need to tap cards directly on the readers and will need to take the physical cards out of their wallets to use before they tap
- **Digital ORCA Cards in Google Wallet**
 - Card readers should default to charging a digital ORCA card when tapped
